### Parliament House Excursion – Civics and Citizenship in Action

Government and democracy are two of the main concepts within Civics and Citizenship for year 6 and 7 students. Visiting South Australia's Parliament House gave students a hands on experience to see government and democracy in action.

On Tuesday, Dr Richard Harvey, our local MP for Newland, provided our room 9/10 students with a detailed presentation about the separation of powers within the Australian Government along with an informative tour of the two houses of parliament. Students had the opportunity to dress up in parliamentary clothing and hold a real debate to see how decision making works in the lower house - The House of Assembly.
