Children's Week is celebrated nationally and includes Universal Children's Day, which falls on the fourth Wednesday in October. It's a week to celebrate Children's rights, talents and citizenship.

This year's theme is based on the Rights of the Child - Article 15 –

Children have the right to choose their friends and connect safely with others.

The SRC are hosting a range of activities for Children's Week, starting on Monday November 1.






A timetable of activities is included below and as you can see we will have a very busy week. On Monday there will be a pre-ordered, whole school sausage sizzle, with sausages being delivered directly to each class.

During the week students can decorate their hand or arm with a temporary body art design (temporary tattoo), with a different age group invited each day to ease the flow of students. This will be held under the shelter by the canteen at each recess time.

Year 4-7 students will have the chance to enter a raffle, and have their name drawn out, to play against the teachers and SRC Executives in a backyard cricket match on the primary oval, which will be played during lunch on Wednesday.

We will finish the week with a casual clothes day and discos on Friday November 5. Students can dress in party clothes or their casual clothes for a gold coin donation during the day on Friday. At lunchtime on Friday we will host a F-1 disco in the school hall for a gold coin donation. After school we will host two discos, year 2 to 4 students from 4:30 pm - 5:30 pm in the school hall and year 5 to 7 students are invited to attend a youth group style disco in the school gym from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Students will need to be dropped off and collected by a parent or caregiver at the entrance of each event. More details can be found on Skoolbag. Each event can be paid for via Qkr! or cash payments on the day.

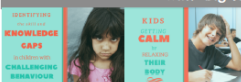
